

2009 Oregon Seafood Festival Wine Competition
Sponsored by Northwest Palate
Rules & Requirements

The 2009 Oregon Seafood Festival Wine Competition is the first commercial competition of the year. Judging will take place on Wednesday, January 21 at the Oregon Convention Center.

Gold, Silver and Bronze medals will be awarded, with no set number of medals awarded. One Best of Show Medal will be awarded. All judges will be selected by Northwest Palate and results of the competition will be immediately released to the media.

Every attempt will be made to have results posted at the festival office at OCC by 5 PM on January 21 and medals will be available for distribution as soon as results are tabulated.

Rules for Entry

Competition is open to all bonded and licensed wineries participating in the 2009 Oregon Seafood & Wine Festival.

There is no limit to the number of entries that you may submit.

Entry will consist of three (3) bottles (750ml, or 375 ml for dessert wines) of each entry plus a fee of \$40 per entry. Registration for the competition must be postmarked by January 12, 2009. Registration forms may be faxed, but payment must reach Events Northwest, Inc. by January 16, 2009. Wines should be shipped the week of January 12-16, 2009 and must be delivered by January 19, 2009. Entry fees are non-refundable.

By submitting an entry you affirm that the entry conforms to all regulations and standards, state & federal.
